



# Manjedal Family Camp

## 17-19 November 2010



Come and join us on a fun packed, heart pounding camp at WA's premier Scout facility at Manjedal, about 10 km south of Byford. This is our annual camp where you can partake of exciting activities and make friends.

### Will you take the challenge?

- Where:** Manjedal Activities Centre 163 Manjedal Drive Karrakup WA
- Date:** Wednesday 17 November – Friday 19 November
- Time:** Registration on arrival 6:00pm Wednesday 17 November  
Camp concludes 4.00 pm Friday 19 November
- Who:** ACC-Southlands families. At least one parent must attend.
- Activities:** Activities include a 15m abseiling tower (11 years and older), 240m flying fox, underground tunnel system, 10m climbing wall (6 years and older), crate climb, low ropes course, navigation, raft building, confidence/commando (obstacle) course, walk trails, a 350m blind trail and a nature trail – and a new gyrotron activity for the young children!  
Evening rally Thursday night: A special program of singing, games and guest speaker Mr Rob Adams from OAC Ministries.

**Note:** Not every child will be able to do every activity and the choice of activities will be dependent on numbers who register.

**Accommodation:** Camping or Dormitories  
The dormitories consist of 3 double bunks per room, 70 beds in total. Some families or children may have to share a room. Dorms are clean but basic (no ensuite). There are ablution blocks for males and females. There are numerous spots for camping with tents.

**Food:** Food is included in the price.

**What to bring:** Outdoor clothes for 2 days: shorts, t-shirts, hat, socks, underwear, jeans, sport shoes, tent and sleeping bag, or bed linen, torch, swimwear, (girls, please bring one piece bathers and t-shirts for swimming), towel, toiletries including soap, toothpaste and toothbrush, Bible, wet weather gear (just in case), medications (please inform us) and a sense of humour.

**What not to bring:** Ipods, mobile phones, immodest or offensive clothing.

**Cost:** Costs are on application form.

#### Manjedal Activities Centre Rules

- Vehicle speed is 15km / hour at all times.
- During staying at Manjedal, access around Manjedal should be via bicycle or walking.
- Vehicles and trailers are prohibited past any point where a sign indicates 'No Parking' or 'No Vehicles'.
- Any standing tree, dead or alive, is not to be marked in any way.
- Respect other sites as you should your own.
- No holes or trenches are to be dug without Management's permission.
- Dispose of rubbish and recycling in the bins provided.
- Do not feed the native animals or leave them food scraps.
- Water is to be used wisely.
- No fires of any size or purpose are to occur during Fire Ban Season.
- Pets are not permitted.
- Ablution lights are not to remain on during sufficient day light.
